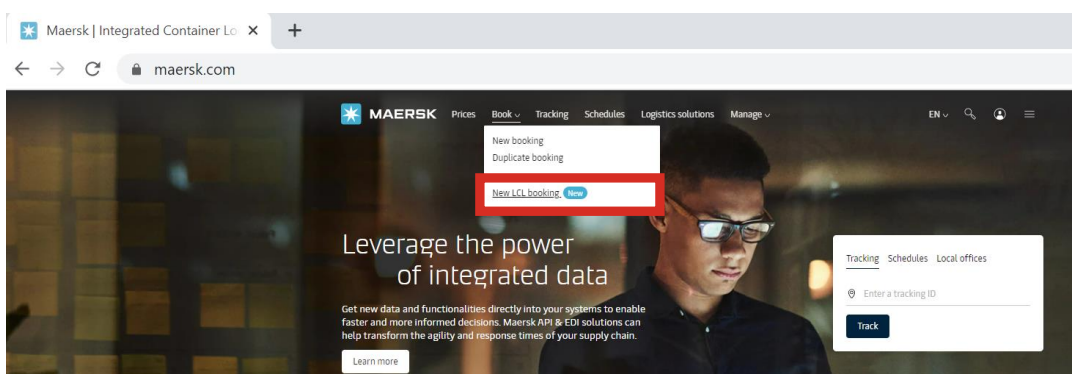


Book new LCL (Less-than container-Load) bookings on maersk.com

Step 1

Go to Maersk.com and log-in with your email and password. Select New LCL booking under Book menu or go to "<https://www.maersk.com/lcl/ocean>" directly.



Step 2. Information

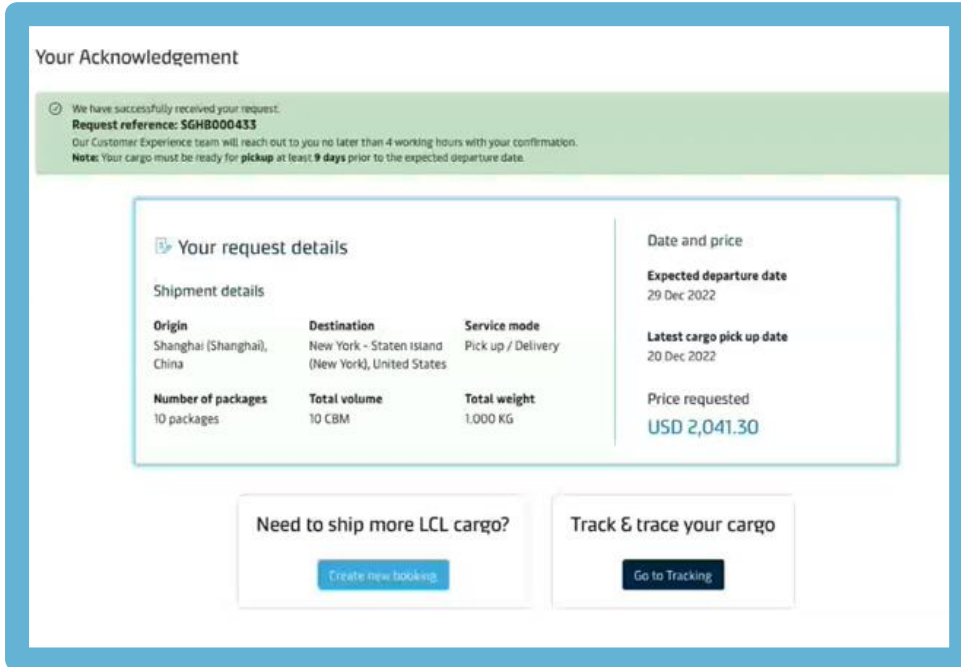
