Due to ongoing geopolitical condition and restrictions affecting cross-border flows, Mawingu service is temporarily suspend from Pakistan.

To maintain service continuity, Maersk has deployed three dedicated sailings of the **SEASPAN CALICANTO**, operating from **Port Qasim to Salalah**, as contingency, will share the alternate product as soon as possible.

The first sailing is scheduled to depart from **Port Qasim Terminal**, offering continued support for cargo movement during this interim period.
